#### Cabernet Sauvignon

- 18. Chile**                      **Colina Negra Cabernet Sauvignon 2006**                      €29.00  
Old vine Cabernet Sauvignon with up front ripe blackcurrant and subtle oak
- 19. California**                **Rutherford Ranch "Napa Valley" Cabernet Sauvignon 2003**                      €32.00  
This Cabernet Sauvignon "Shines" when paired with savoury beef dishes. It is full bodied and has excellent use of oak

#### Merlot

- 20. Chile**                      **Torreon Reserve Merlot 2006**                      €25.00  
Black fruits, cassis and chocolate, with a smoky character. This wine is ready to drink but will age for several years
- 21. France**                      **Les Jamelles Merlot 2003/04**                      €22.00  
The wine is round, fat and long in the mouth. It's velvety with mature tannins at The end. It is well balanced and easy to drink
- 22. Australia**                **Hungerford Hill Orange Merlot 2003**                      €34.00  
This wine is extremely smooth and elegant with lovely plumy chocolate overtones. It has a long finish and the want for more

#### Syrah / Shiraz

- 23. South Africa**              **Lushof Shiraz 2004**                      €29.00  
Lovely black fruit aromas with hints of spice and black pepper
- 24. Australia**                **Ferngrove Shiraz 2004**                      €28.50  
This wine exhibits primary mulberry/blackberry and liquorice characters, as well as toasted oak scents.
- 25. Australia**                **Hungerford Hill Orange Shiraz 2003**                      €34.00  
Full bodied and laden with spice, liquorice and black pepper. This wine is true 'Aussie style' Shiraz

#### Other Varietals

- 26. Spain (Rioja)**              **Remondo La Montesa 2004**                      €32.00  
From world wine maker 2006 Alvaro Palacios. This wine is stunning and excellent With lamb..
- 27. France (Rhône)**            **Cotes Du Rhône Village Olivier Ravoire**                      €23.00  
A classic southern Rhône wine which exhibits real fruit aromas of liquorice and black fruits
- 28. Argentina**                **Don David Reserve Malbec 2004**                      €24.50  
Plum tobacco and oak, rich and concentrated flavours, with a long and pleasant aftertaste.

- 29. Chile Paso De Luz Carmenere Reserve Especial 2004** €24.00  
Deep ruby colour with ripe red fruit aromas, cassis, spice & coffee flavours, a velvety mouth feel & a rich complex finish
- 30. France (Burgundy) Lupe Cholet Fluerie 2005** €33.00  
Lovely red fruits of strawberry and raspberry with a soft and elegant finish
- 31. N. Zealand Seifried Pinot Noir 2004** €35.00  
Ripe black cherry fruit on the nose with gentle oak influences and a flavourful finish
- 32. Spain Marques De Riscal Reserva 2003** €36.00  
Classic oakey bouquet, lovely sweet rich fruit, mellow rounded & supple with length and flavour

### Half Bottles

- 33. Chile Torreon De Paredes Sauvignon Blanc** €12.00  
Fresh tropical fruits, with floral and typical notes. Drink on its own or with light dishes.
- 34. Chile Torreon De Paredes Merlot** €12.00  
Black fruits, herbal and floral aromas with touches of liquoice, plum and chocolate. Soft and long on the palate

### Champagne / Sparkling

- 35. Italy Masottina Prosecco Frizante** €33.00  
Pale lemon gold colour, fresh bouquet, crisp elegant finish with depth of flavour
- 36. France Veuve Clicquot, Yellow Label NV** €75.00  
Champagne from Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes. Intense fruity nose, flowery, fresh and lively with great balance and length
- 37. France Champagne Pannier "Rose"** €35.00  
Champagne from Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes. Ripe red fruits (cherry / raspberry) can be detected. A balanced aftertaste both length and finesse
